Bill holds an Associate's Degree in Visual Arts and received his Bachelor's in Philosophy and Master's in Systematic Theology from St. Charles Borromeo Seminary in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Bill travels the country speaking on TOB and the New Evangelization, not only through the Institute, but through missionmoment.org, a speaking ministry he founded eight years ago. He teaches at Malvern Preparatory School, as well as Immaculata University and lives outside of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania with his wife and son.

This course examines the main themes of the following works of John Paul II: *On the Christian Family in the Modern World*, *On the Dignity & Vocation of Women*, *Letter to Women* and *Letter to Families*. Particular attention will be paid to the themes presented in the Wednesday Catechesis on the body. Gender, marriage and family will be analyzed on the basis of John Paul II's teaching that the human body is the expression of the person and that the differences in masculinity and femininity point to the invitation by God to love as He loves.

This course intends to:

- Synthesize the main themes of *Familiaris Consortio*, *Mulieris Dignitatem*, *Letter to Women* and *Letter to Families*.
- Analyze the significance of masculinity and femininity as two incarnations of the human person as an image of God.
- Compare and contrast John Paul II's integral vision of gender and sexual difference with modern secular views of gender and sexual difference.
- Compare and contrast the family as an image of Trinitarian Love and a "domestic church" with modern secular views of the family.
- Apply John Paul II's definition of "fairest love" to a multitude of concrete situations.

Michael Waldstein, Ph.D. is the Max Seckler Professor of Theology at Ave Maria University. He previously served as founding president of the International Theological Institute in Gaming, Austria, and was the St. Francis of Assisi Professor of New Testament there. He is a member of the Pontifical Council for the Family and is a Distinguished Fellow of the St. Paul Center for Biblical Theology. He holds the degrees of B.A. from Thomas Aquinas College in California, Ph.D. in Philosophy from the University of Dallas, S.S.L. from the Pontifical Biblical Institute in Rome, and a Th.D. in New Testament from Harvard Divinity School. His published works include his definitive translation of John Paul II's *Man and Woman He Created Them: A Theology of the Body*.

All our week-long courses include:

- Five days of learning and interactive lecture (30 hours of classroom time).
- Time for relaxation and networking with other TOB enthusiasts surrounded by 100 acres of beautiful wooded countryside at Black Rock Retreat Center in Quarryville, PA (50 miles west of Philadelphia).
- Daily Mass, adoration, and confession.
- Optional round trip shuttle from the Philadelphia Airport.
